

DESCRIPTION

GORILLA Tech Glue (CRP-15) is solvent based formulated for Carpet application contact adhesive, based on Polychloroprene. This has been developed specially for use in tropical and hot climates.

APPLICATION

- It can also be used for all types of flooring construction porous & non-porous surfaces.
- For fixing Carpet, Felt Backing Vinyl Floor Tiles.
- It is easy to apply by roller or brush.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Make sure that surfaces are dry, clean, free oil and grease or any foreign particles. The wet coverage of the adhesive is 4 – 6 m²/kg subject to porosity of the substrate, film thickness and nature of material being bonded. Uniformly apply the adhesive on floor using roller or brush. Application may also be applied by punching holes on the bottom of the Can Packaging and allow to flow uniformly on the floor. Allow 10 -15 minutes till sticky dry, while adjustment on carpet can be made. Apply pressure to the carpet to ensure adhesion. Allow to cure for 24 Hrs. to get good results.

STORAGE:

- Stored tightly closed in a well ventilated area between 5°C to 39°C. Keep away from direct sunlight
- Store away from ignition sources.
- Stirring is recommended before use.
- Shelf life is up to 12 months in unopened container when stored as directed.

HEALTH & SAFETY:
